<p>Hello all, I have tested this on XFCE 4.10/Unity/Gnome. 0.8.0 version has a working tray icon in any DE, but 0.9.0 only works in KDE. I seem to notice this behavior regardless of what distribution I try.. Arch/Fedora/Ubuntu all show the same symptoms.</p> <p>Basically 0.9.0 does not have a tray icon that works in anything except KDE. Thank you for any assistance that can be provided.</p>
