It saves everything you type into a new line and hit key_up/key_down or return afterwards.

History got a maximum size of 1000 entries for now. This could be made configurable but i guess it's ok until (if ever) there's a search function for the history. Probably no one will search 1000 lines by hand just to be "faster" than typing the same thing again..
