<b>Description</b> QT5 (the basis of current quassel) will go out of maintenance and the successor QT6 is already there for a good while. To have quassel alive in the future, a port to QT6 will be required as distros might drop QT5 and therefore Quassel, too.  There is a compatibility library ( <a href="https://download.qt.io/archive/qt/6.8/6.8.1/submodules/qt5compat-everywhere-src-6.8.1.tar.xz">https://download.qt.io/archive/qt/6.8/6.8.1/submodules/qt5compat-everywhere-src-6.8.1.tar.xz</a> ) which might help getting Quassel go on QT6.
