As long as the core is stopped cleanly (ie. SIGTERM or SIGINT) a Quit message is written to all buffers.

If the core is stopped otherwise ( SIGABRT, SIGSEGV, SIGBUS, SIGKILL) there is no quit message. And there is just nothing we can do about it
