<b>Description</b> I'm running Gentoo Linux, with Quassel 0.3.0.3 and KDE 4.1.72. <freedrich|> Sput: the problem happens when you have quassel set to "minimize to tray on close". So, on KDE's shutdown it probably receives a "Quit" event, but instead of quitting it tells kde "nope, I want to go to the tray again" and cancels the Shutdown/Restart process that way.
