| Description Given the scenario where two clients, A and B, are logged into the same user on the same core, and both of those clients are set not to show own messages in the chatmonitor - if client A sends a message to a buffer, as expected this does not appear in client A's chatmonitor, however it does appear in client B's chatmonitor. This is presumably because the message appears as incoming (core -> client) to client B. | | | |
