<p>I have a custom chat list with "unread" channels (minimum activity: 'new message'). When there is new stuff in more than a channel in one network (like the famous moepnet), than if I click on one chatroom, the chatroom is correctly presented, but the focus of the tree-element is off by one. Like this:</p> <p>moepnet: #something #news #paniks</p> <p>clicking on #news</p> <p>moepnet: #something #news [#paniks]</p> <p>so #news is shown, but "#paniks" is highlighted in the list. Version is actually 0.7-pre+93 (http://git.quassel-irc.org/?p=quassel.git;a=commit;h=e223b940bbb059f9fb56db1aa70cd72bcabf1d0b)</p>
